Budget

Sandia received \$5.1 Billion in funding in FY24 from Oct. 1, 2023 through Sept. 30, 2024. Most came through U.S. Department of Energy funds, including \$3.3 Billion under the DOE's National Nuclear Security Administration. Weapons Activities accounted for more than \$2.9 Billion of the NNSA portion, while Defense Nuclear Nonproliferation received \$348 Million.

The DOE budget also included funding from various DOE program offices. Sandia also received approximately \$1.4 Billion in Strategic Partnership Projects and other non-DOE funding.


Employees

In FY24, Sandia had a workforce of 16,915, including 14,219 regular employees; 1,177 limited-term employees; 1,116 students; 384 post-docs; and fewer than 20 faculty/recurrent staff.
